THE GOAL OF THE COMPETITION:

- Deciding the 2025 Youth Curling Championship title.
- Developing domestic curling sport
- Promoting curling among junior competitors.
- To assure competition opportunity for the member teams of Hungarian Curling Federation and for foreign teams as well.

EVENTS:

Girl's team: (6 players, 4 players + 1 alternate per game)

- For the Girl's teams and players which are members of Hungarian Curling Federation
- Possible to enter for foreign girl's teams too, if they suit for other conditions (sending entry form, entry fee in time, accepting competition rules, etc.)

Boy's team: (6 players, 4 players + 1 alternate per game)

- For the Boy's teams and players which are members of Hungarian Curling Federation
- Possible to enter for foreign boy's teams too, if they suit for other conditions (sending entry form, entry fee in time, accepting competition rules, etc.)

Deadline of entry: 14. March 2025. 16:00

Entry fee: 150 EUR

TIME TABLE OF THE COMPETITION:

- Depends on the number of the participation.

PRIZES:

I-II-III. - Medals in Open category

Medals: On site, immediately after the end of finals.

PARTICIPANTS:

- All teams which meet the requirements
- Which have sent their entry and entry fee until the deadline
- Which respect the rules of WCF and the rules of the competition
- Which respect the rules of fair play and don't disturb the others by their behavior.

RULES OF THE COMPETITION:

- The time available for the teams is 80 minutes + the already started end can be finished (running clock).
- The end is considered to have started if the first stone of the next end crossed the thrower side's tee line.
- First named teams in each draw play the stones with the dark-coloured handles. Second named teams in each draw play the stones with the light-coloured handles.
- Before the warm up the teams take one (1) minute cooling. After that, there will be a five (5) minute warm up, followed by the LSDs for both teams before the round robin games (1+1 minutes for each throw). The first practice starts twenty (20) minutes before the game's start time.
- There is no break between ends during the match, nor is there a half-time break. The coaches may enter the field of play between ends and communicate with the teams without prolonging the game.
- In games, both teams may request time-outs 2-2 times. A time-out may be called at any stage of the match.
- Six (6) ends are scheduled with extra end to decide tied matches. A minimum of four (4) ends must be completed in the round robin matches and all play-off matches.

- If a team has no mathematical chance for winning it has to abandon the match after the 4th end. In this case the written sign of the non-played ends are "X".
- The ranking in the round robin system:
 - 1. points
 - 2. In case of equality of points: result against the team which has the same points
 - 3. Average Draw Shot Challenge result
- In other cases, the rules of WCF are valid.
- The Organizing Committee has right to angle from these rules in extraordinary cases.
- The skips have to sign the report about the match after they have finished it.
- During the competition, the WCF rules will apply
- If any question/request arises about the competition an e-mail to the head of the Organising Committee will be considered as an official statement. Questions, requests, and any disputes that may occur will be discussed and decided upon by the Organising Committee. The Head of the Organising Committee will inform the person(s) concerned of the decision.
- The players who have no special curling shoes can rent sliders from the curling Club for free. For them necessary to wear clear training shoes.

OTHER RULES AND GUIDELINES:

- If a team requests a change in the timetable, they will cover the extra costs.
- In case of match cancellation, the defaulting team will be entitled to 75 minutes of practice time. Please inform the Organising Committee whether or not the defaulting team will take this opportunity. The practice time will start at the time the match starts
- It is not allowed to throw away the first stone of an end before the expiry of the time that marks the pause between ends. In the next 10 seconds the teams have time to throw the first stone of the next end, after that the judges start the team's thinking time. The same applies to the half-time break.
- The skips have to sign the report about the match after they have finished it.
- For unsportsmanlike behaviour, the referee may issue a warning, or exclude a team from further competition. Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in Ethics and Disciplinary proceedings!

TECHICAL INFORMATION:

• We ask the players to keep the ice clean. Please step to the ice only in cleaned shoes. Please don't touch the ice with your hands.

OTHERS:

• Every player can compete only on his own liability.

• The teams and the players due to keep the "house rules" of the Curling Club.
